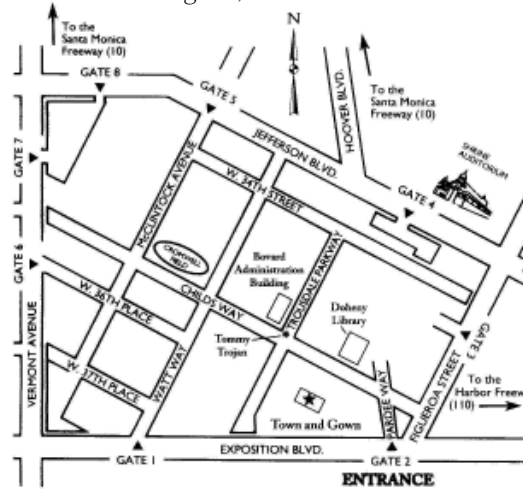

Enter Pardee Way through Gate 2 on Exposition Blvd.
Parking Rate: \$7.00 per vehicle (Childs Way parking lot)

From San Diego Fwy (405) Northbound Take the 405 to Interstate 105 East. Connect to the 110 North. Exit at 37th Street/ Exposition Blvd. Merge onto Exposition and continue westbound. Just after you cross Figueroa, turn right onto Pardee Way (Gate 2). The gate attendant will direct you to Town & Gown. **Southbound** Take the 405 to the 10 (Santa Monica Fwy). Go eastbound on the 10. Connect to the 110 South. Exit at Exposition and make a right (westbound). Just after you cross Figueroa, turn right onto Pardee Way (Gate 2). The gate attendant will direct you to Town & Gown.

From Hollywood Fwy. (101) Take the 101 to the 110 South. Exit at Exposition and make a right (westbound). Just after crossing Figueroa, make a right onto Pardee Way (Gate 2). The gate attendant will direct you to Town & Gown.

From Santa Monica Fwy. (10) Exit at Hoover and turn right. Head south on Hoover until it ends at Jefferson. Turn left onto Jefferson and then right onto Figueroa. At the next major intersection, make a right onto Exposition. Turn right onto Pardee Way (Gate 2). The gate attendant will direct you to Town & Gown.

From Harbor Fwy. (110) Northbound Exit at Exposition and continue west on Exposition after merging. Just after you cross Figueroa, turn right into Gate 2. The gate attendant will direct you to Town & Gown. **Southbound** Exit at Exposition and make a right (westbound). Just after you cross Figueroa, turn right onto Pardee Way (Gate 2). The gate attendant will direct you to Town & Gown.
